Throughout history Touring Superleggera has had a very deep relationship with BMW, the Historic Relation went so far and deep, that the Carozzeria Touring was requested by BMW to provide the Superleggera Coach-Body, for the BMW 328.

In 1940 the BMW 328 could win the Mille Miglia with the famous Touring Superleggera bodywork – a sensation. In the 80s BMW asked Mr. Carlo Felice Bianchi Anderloni and the famous designer Ercole Spada, to support the reconstruction of the famous BMW 328 car, which was lost and now is on display in the BMW Museum.

We will also visit HK - Engineering one of the most important restoration companies of the world of the famous Mercedes 300 SL Gullwing and Roadsters.

HK ENGENEERING located in an unique place, the historic Monastery Polling, brings back to life the cars that represents the birth of the initials SL (Sport Light) which still lives today and gives prestige to the Mercedes brand.

10:00 Hours: Visit of the Pilgrimage Church of Wies

The "Wieskirche" is an oval Rococo church, designed in the late 1740s by brothers J. B. and Dominikus Zimmermann, the latter of whom lived nearby for the last eleven years of his life. It is located in the foothills of the Alps, in the municipality of Steingaden in the Weilheim-Schongau district of Bavaria. Because of its outstanding rococo architecture, the Wieskirche was added to the UNESCO World Heritage List in 1983.

11:00 Hours: Visit of "King Ludwig II Castel Neuschwanstein"

The Neuschwanstein Castle is a 19th-century historicist palace on a rugged hill of the foothills of the Alps in the very south of Germany, just north of the Austrian border. It is located in the Swabia region of Bavaria, above the incorporated village of Hohenschwangau, which is also the location of Hohenschwangau Castle.

Despite the main residence of the Bavarian monarchs at the time — the Munich Residenz — being one of the most extensive palace complexes in the world, King Ludwig II of Bavaria felt the need to escape from the constraints he saw himself exposed to in Munich, and commisssioned

Neuschwanstein Palace on the remote northern edges of the Alps as a retreat, but also in honour of composer Richard Wagner, whom he greatly admired.

Ludwig chose to pay for the palace out of his personal fortune and by means of extensive borrowing, rather than Bavarian public funds. Construction began in 1869, but was never completed. The castle was intended to serve as a private residence for the king, but he died in 1886 and it was opened to the public shortly after his death.
